

Call for Special Sessions

MISSI 2010 Program Committees solicit proposals for special sessions within the scopes of the MISSI Conference. Special sessions, to be organized by international recognized experts, aim to bring together researchers in special focused topics. Their objective is to complement the regular program with new or emerging topics of particular interest. A special session will consist of a group of papers in a sub-discipline of multimedia and network information systems related to the main topics of the conference. The papers will be required to meet the same standards.

Papers submitted for special sessions are to be peer-reviewed with the same criteria used for the contributed papers.
